All riders must ride alone and unassisted, and neither give nor take pace from any other rider.
The onus is on the overtaken rider to drop back.

BAR points awarded by Age Category determined by Actual Time.

ALL RIDERS AND HELPERS MUST BE PAID-UP MEMBERS OF EMCC.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

START at the south end of the pedestrian river bridge under Anthony Henday Drive.
Proceed north on the paved trail to FINISH at the power pole on the north side of the trail in the TransAlta right-of-way, approximately 100 m west of Heath Road NW.

DO NOT CROSS THE YELLOW CENTRELINE ON THE TRAIL – the roving marshal will be looking for infractions.

“While on Parkland no person shall operate a Bicycle unless the Bicycle is equipped with a working bell.” And, **“Every person using a Bicycle on an Improved Trail or an Unimproved Trail shall alert anyone about to be overtaken by sounding a bell a reasonable amount of time before overtaking.”**
(Parkland Bylaw 2202).

PARKING

THIS IS A RESIDENTIAL AREA – PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL AND COURTEOUS.

There is very limited parking on Heath Road. Do not park within 5 m of the marked pedestrian crossing, or in the bus stop. Do not park in front of a house.

Adequate curbside parking is available on the west side of Hector Road (first road off Heath Road south of TransAlta), adjacent to the playing fields.

Alternatively, ride your bike to the event!
